

Equipment

Cello maintenance and care is an important responsibility and will be taught in the first lesson. Most students choose to rent their instrument until they outgrow it or decide to buy a better quality one. Ask your teacher for suggestions on area shops.

Each student should have:

- rosin
- endpin rest (Xeros strap is preferred, otherwise a rock stop)
- cleaning rag
- medium or large blank notebook
- an appropriately sized chair, which may include adjustable stools or custom-made cello chairs
